

THE TRANSFER OF THE PRIZE

HOW IT WORKS

We also give £50 to each property seller who lists their property with us and is approved for a competition listing.

THE DRAW

As a competition, as opposed to a raffle, (and therefore without the need to be registered with the UK Gambling Commission) only participants who submit the correct answer to the competition question are considered for a prize.
